ROOT CAUSE ANALYSIS:

GETTING TO THE ROOT OF THE MATTER

What is Root Cause Analysis (RCA)?

A process used to define, evaluate, and systematically analyze “a problem” to determine the underlying factors or reasons for the problem

A nonconformity = a problem, error, instance of noncompliance, or missed opportunity

Root cause analysis is a series of tools that work in concert with each other, rather than as a single approach. Using these tools, one is able to identify the key to an issue and take steps to ensure that the problem does not reoccur.

Why Root Cause Analysis for Fraud Examiners?

- Because what you see may not always be fraudulent!
- The red flags of fraud may be present due to challenges, problems, or change in an organization, yet not actually be fraud.
- Red flags only point to where to look, not what has caused a problem.
- When fraud is not found, we must be able to explain what is really happening.
- Root Cause Analysis will help us understand and explain the “what” and the “why” behind issues
- When fraud is found, Root Cause Analysis will help better explain and correct the problems that led to the opportunity for fraud.

You will learn how to:

- Define what Root Cause Analysis (RCA) is and how it helps solve problems
- Recognize tools and methodologies that can be utilized for Root Cause Analysis
- Discuss why Root Cause Analysis is important for fraud examiners
- Discuss when to utilize Root Cause Analysis in an investigation
- Explain the common challenges when using Root Cause Analysis
